







# Bleach safety

	<b>BLEACH SANITIZER</b> food contact surfaces and mouthed objects 5.25-6.00% and 8.25% & bleach concentrations	<b>BLEACH DISINFECTANT</b> diapering, toileting and hand-washing areas 5.25 - 6.00% bleach concentrations	<b>BLEACH DISINFECTANT</b> diapering, toileting and hand-washing areas 8.25% bleach concentrations
<b>Quart</b>	 <p>1 pump bleach to 1 quart (32 oz.) water</p> <p>1 pump = 1/4 teaspoon bleach</p>	 <p>3 pumps bleach to 1 quart (32 oz.) water</p> <p>3 pumps = 1 Tablespoon bleach</p>	 <p>2 pumps bleach to 1 quart (32 oz.) water</p> <p>2 pumps = 1.5 teaspoons bleach</p>
<b>Gallon</b>	 <p>3 pumps bleach to 1 gallon (128 oz.) water</p> <p>3 pumps = 1 teaspoon bleach</p>	 <p>12 pumps bleach to 1 gallon (128 oz.) water</p> <p>12 pumps = 1/4 cup of bleach</p>	 <p>8 pumps bleach to 1 gallon (128 oz.) water</p> <p>8 pumps = 2 Tablespoons</p>

## Steps for using bleach

### REDUCE EXPOSURE

#### Keep children away while mixing, sanitizing or disinfecting.

- Purchase fragrance-free, regular strength bleach.
- Wear gloves, protective eyewear and apron.
- Open doors and windows to let in fresh air.
- Measure carefully.
- Mix in standard quart (32 oz.) or gallon (128 oz.) containers.

### PROPER MIXING

#### Bleach breaks down quickly in water. Make solutions fresh each day.

- Mix bleach with room-temperature water.
- After mixing, test sanitizer's strength with a test strip.

### PROPER USE

#### Label all bottles and buckets either "Bleach Sanitizer" or "Bleach Disinfectant."

- Clean surfaces first with soap and water. Rinse with clean water.
- Let surfaces air-dry, or set timer for two minutes and wipe dry.

### SAFE PRACTICES

#### Store bleach and solutions out of reach of children and away from food.
