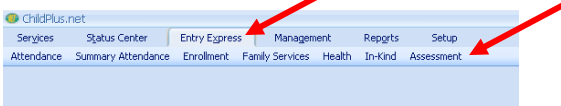
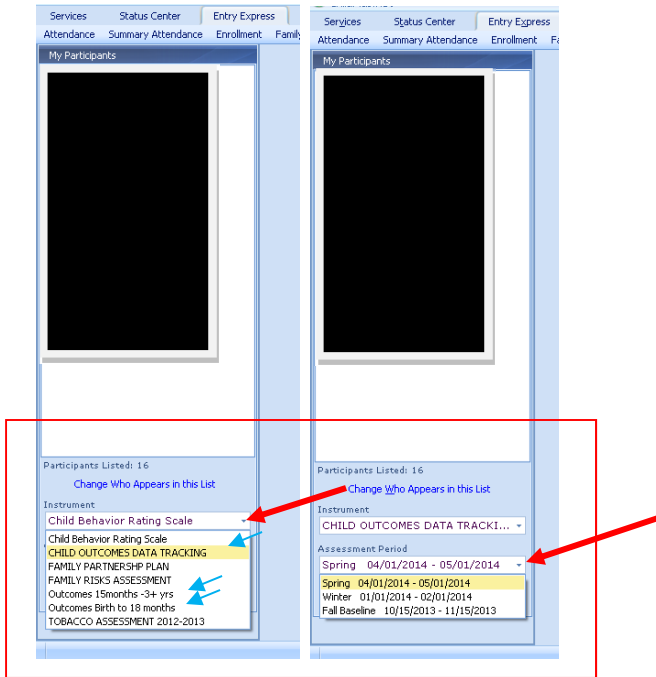


How to enter Outcomes in to ChildPlus

1. Go to "Entry Express", then "Assessment"

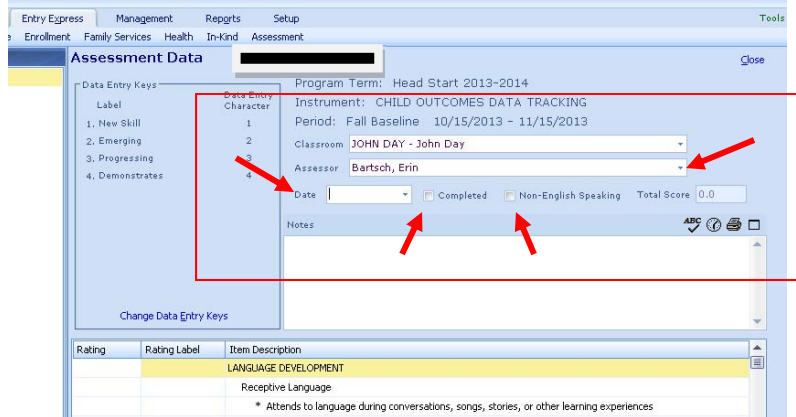


2. Make sure you have your current children appearing.
3. Select the Outcomes for the age child you are assessing, and then select the time frame you assessed in.



4. Select a Child, then enter assessment data:

Make sure you are the assessor
Enter the date you assessed
Check "Completed"
Check "Non-English Speaking" if they are a dual language learner



- Enter in the scores by the indicator. You can use the mouse or the key pad, if you use the key pad it will move to the next indicator automatically. Only score the ELD indicators if you check "Non-English Speaking", indicated by the child's primary language by the parent (regardless of whether they also have English listed.)
