Child and Dependent Care Tax Credits

You may be able to deduct part of your child care expenses from federal & state taxes. File federal & state tax returns to receive these benefits.

Earned Income Tax Credits

Low-income, working families may be eligible for these benefits, even if taxes are not owed. File federal & state income tax returns to apply.

Employment/Education-Related Day care Fund (ERDC)

Federal & state child care funds are available to low-income, working families from the Department of Human Services.

Employer-supported benefits

Federal & state tax incentives exist for employers who offer child care subsidies, on-site child care or Dependent Care Assistance Plans (pre-tax dollars set aside for child care).

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Co-Operative Preschools

Some preschools offer lower cost to parents who participate in program activities.

Sliding Fee Schedules/Scholarships

Depending on income, families may be eligible for lower fees based on sliding fee scales or multiple children.

Families may also be eligible to apply for scholarships.

Head Start or Other Government Funded Programs

Families may be eligible for free or reduced cost programs that receive federal or state funds.
