Develop a "walk about" route with the family	Paper, pen	Walkability checklist deals with issues of pedestrian safety
Review good pedestrian safety and the types of things that you will be looking for on the walk	Pedestrian Safety Brochure, Walkability Checklist	While completing the walk, tell child why it is a pedestrian safety concern, and safer way
Complete Neighborhood Walk, utilizing the Walkability Checklist. Discuss concerns as you identify them	Walkability Checklist, Pen or marker	Set a deadline as to when they will take actions on the concerns, and a follow-up date
After the walk, identify the parents' main concerns, and what they can do immediately about the concerns	Walkability checklist	Where the child can and can not go? Who needs to know where the child is at? Who do you talk to in an emergency? (phone number list, emergency numbers, a neighbor or apartment manager that could be called)
Parent/Child Activity: Develop rules for going outside or to the neighbors to visit friends	Paper, pen, and Emergency resource number pocket guide	
If Neighborhood Watch is offered in your community, talk with the family about getting involved with it. If it is not offered, talk with the family about talking with the police department to start a Neighborhood Watch program
